Call to order	Tappan called the meeting to order at 1:57 p.m.	
Meeting minutes	• The minutes from the 1-18-18 meeting were unanimously approved.	
Graduate Committee Update	 Treise gave an overview of the Graduate Committee. This committee oversees graduate student awards; she also went over a new defense attendance policy. Treise reported that beginning in fall 2018, there will be an increase in funding for Ph.D. students. The Provost also agreed to fund research assistants. The point of this increase is to attract the most competitive candidates. 	
Research Committee Update	 Treise announced that the Committee is again facilitating the third Research Symposium. The 26 submissions were excellent, both in terms of quality and diversity of topics. Doctoral students in the fall 2017 cohort are currently enrolled in the first required grants writing class. The Committee also selects award winners, for example the Faculty Research Award and the Summer Faculty Research Award. That selection process will take place this semester. 	
Faculty Development and Welfare Committee Update	 Pelfrey gave an update on the Faculty Development and Welfare Committee. The Committee facilitated the Tenure and Promotion Workshop on January 17. The Committee has begun to do research on 	

	mentoring best practices at other universities and	
	other colleges at UF, including the law school and	
	school of medicine. The Committee plans to	
	review this research for the remainder of this	
	semester and potentially into the fall semester	
	before coming back with some recommendations.	
	• The other task the Committee is working on is the	
	well-being of faculty more generally (not just as it	
	pertains to junior faculty and promotion). The	
	Committee is researching aspirational programs,	
	such as a conference in 2016, Launching SUNY	
	Initiatives in Mindfulness and Health, that could	
	inform a mindfulness and well-being program	
	here. The Committee would like this to be	
	considered for the faculty retreat in the fall.	
Other Business	Tappan noted that the Faculty Senate would soon	
	need to form an election sub-committee. She also	
	noted Churchill Roberts is rolling off the	
	University Faculty Senate and will need to be	
	replaced.
