Town Hall Notes

Walsh Childers called to order at 1:30; 41 participants including task force members

Explained the committees charge, the process, and reason for the town hall. Sheehan made a small presentation about the budgeting process for the CJC

Walsh Childers opened the floor to questions about the principles presented by the work group.

Comments:

Try to stay as close as possible to the present faculty to student ratio. Impactful to overall health.

Questions:

What is not a priority since everything seems to be a priority?

Discussions occurred about the specificity or lack thereof about the draft principles

What opportunities are there to have more specific input to tactics for addressing line item/specific cuts.

Ranking the principles? - Walsh Childers suggested adding an option on the survey about the staff and faculty's preference for ranking the principles. 'I choose not to rank the principles'

Subheadings: Some principles are specific to process

Different individuals made suggestions for if and how ratings/rankings should occur.

Walsh Childers addressed the next steps of the process and the fact that a survey would be disseminated to get input from the staff and faculty before the principles are submitted to the Dean and Associate Dean.

Open ended part of the survey to capture ways to be transparent in the process of budget cutting.

Walsh-Childers suggested that one of the recommendations may be that CJC staff and faculty are interested in hearing how the decisions are made throughout the process (transparency) and having the opportunity to offer suggestions.

Survey will release Tuesday afternoon. Will close on Thursday at noon. Next task force meeting scheduled for Thursday afternoon before the final submission to the Dean on Friday, May 15th.
