- **Diane** called the meeting to order at 2:03 p.m.

CJC Plans for International Week

Dr. Kiouisis said UF is having International Week the third week of November. They have asked various Colleges to notify them if they are holding any events. He said that the College has decided to focus on one day. We have planned a series of panels and discussions that Weigold and the PATH office have agreed to coordinate.

Weigold went on to explain details of the festivities for the College's International day. He encouraged everyone to attend especially their students. Kiouisis also emphasized everyone to recruit as many people to participate in this event.

UF Online

- **Carlson** handed out a spreadsheet reflecting the Media and Society undergraduate online degree that the College is launching this spring. He went to explain that the colors on the spreadsheet indicated the credit hours for each course. He said Chairs will need to start creating an extra section for these courses because they will have a different charge from the other classes. This for tracking purposes.
- **Ostroff** discussed how these courses were selected. He said there is number of courses we are not required to offer. He said at this point we are not ready to offer these other courses online. He showed the group how to add the extra sections.
- **Weigold** went on to explain compensation for online courses. He said UF online will bring us off book revenue, he summarized it to be about \$450 per student per 3 credit class and went on to give examples of this. UF puts a cap on it and will not pay us more than \$10,000.
- **Kiouisis** added that we want to work through everything we can with Telecom Media Society and possibly expand later. He said to refer all inquiries to Weigold. He said at this point we really want to focus on Media and Society and then hopefully it will lead to expand to later.

Student recruitment efforts

- **Hopson** gave an update on the Agency. He said they changed the color scheme and look of the Agency. They did research and found this is what attracts millennial. They have the job descriptions and he said applications are due soon. Posters advertising positions will be going up today.

Open Discussion

- **Bennett** announced that after International week is Entrepreneurship week. He said they will be having two entrepreneur speakers in G037 and more details to come. He said they created a separate University LinkIn page and explain how to get to this page.
