The students should discuss their results with their advisors prior to final registration to determine if they should take MMC 6421 or opt out. Goodman seconded the motion.

Discussion followed regarding the need for students to have a broad knowledge of research within the first semester. It was suggested that all faculty who teach a research methods course should meet and determine the basics that should be covered in each class.

Motion was approved.
